




Fall is a time of new beginnings: fresh starts at school, new sports seasons, a shift in the air. And with new beginnings come expectations.

Some expectations are healthy and energizing, like those tied to an expectant mother or the start of a new venture. Our faith even calls us to live with expectation: trusting in God's goodness and grace.

But expectations can also burden us. They can lead to disappointment, resentment, or disillusionment. Some people lower their expectations so much that they stop hoping altogether. That's no way to live.

In this series, we'll explore the hidden power of expectations, both the ones that weigh us down and the ones that lift us up. We'll invite our community to examine what they expect from God, others, and themselves, and to let go of the unrealistic and embrace the hope-filled.



At Assumption, we preach in message series. Over several weeks, we will examine a topic in depth. We select a topic based on the weekend's scripture readings.

God speaks to us at every moment, especially in a community setting, when His people come together on Sundays and listen to

the Word of God as we celebrate, pray, praise, and thank God. Then the discussion continues in the Small Groups and goes deeper. Our message series usually runs from September to July. Our mission continues to Love God, Serve Others, and Grow Disciples.

# **Drug Crisis Assistance**


